Tami Wilhelm has been working as a certified brailist for over 20 years. Tami holds certifications in EBAE, UEB, Nemeth Braille Code, and as a Nemeth Braille Proofreader. She contracted with the Library of Congress for ten years where she was a Nemeth instructor for the Nemeth Braille Code preparing students for the Nemeth Certification Test. In addition, she was also a board member for the National Braille Association; there she chaired the Tactile Committee and provided workshops to attendees on how to create a raised line drawing focusing on the collage method. She has presented this workshop for several agencies and volunteer groups in Florida, Texas, Kansas, Kentucky and Georgia. She currently is the Certified Brailist for the Nebraska Center for the Education of Children who are Blind and Visually Impaired (NCECBVI).
